SUMMER UNIFORM

- ❖ **GIRLS** The official Kilmaine sweatshirt may be worn over a white polo shirt as a cooler alternative to shirt, tie and cardigan. Footwear – black shoes **not** trainers. Yellow gingham dresses may be worn with official Kilmaine sweatshirts, or a white cardigan (**no leggings please**). - ❖ **BOYS** The official Kilmaine sweatshirt may be worn over a white polo shirt as a cooler alternative to shirt, tie and pullover. Footwear - black shoes **not** trainers.
