

Home Learning May Include:

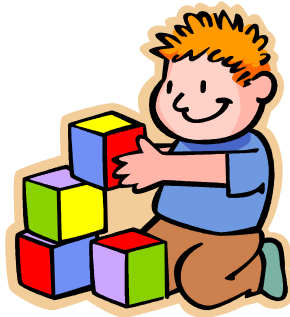
- Reading/reading games

How Can Parents Help?

- Provide a reasonably peaceful, suitable place to work.
- Offer support and encouragement.
- Value Home Learning.
- Praise your child when work is completed.
- Aim to spend no longer than 20 minutes. If a task takes longer, stop! Tell your child's teacher.
- Keep a note of the Homework Timetable.
- Help your child to return work to school on time.

Home Learning Timetable

Reception

Approx 10 Minutes Daily	Reading	Return to school each day.
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Year 1

Friday	Maths Spellings/ English	Return on Thursday Practise at home
10 - 15 Mins Daily	Reading	Return to school each day.

Year 2

Thursday	Spellings /Maths English	Return on Wednesday
10 - 15 Mins Daily	Reading	Return to school each day.

Year 3

Friday	Maths/Tables Spellings/English	Return on Friday
10 - 15 Mins Daily	Reading	Return to school each day.



Year 4

Monday	Maths English/Topic	Return by Monday of following week
10 - 15 Mins Daily	Tables/Spellings	Return to school each day.

Year 5

Mon	Maths/Tables	Return on Wednesday
Tues	Topic	Return on Monday
Weds	English	Return on Monday
Thursday	Topic	Return on Monday
Fri	Spellings	Return on Friday
10 - 15 Mins Daily	Reading	Return to school each day.

All Children:

Pupils may have occasional topic based work.

Pupils may have additional work e.g. finding out some history facts, science work etc. as and when appropriate.

All children will be encouraged to extend their learning by bringing in things from home to support their work in school.

NB- Home learning should not be too demanding or challenging. If at any time your child is in difficulty or becomes frustrated, STOP! Please let your child's teacher know!
