



Pupil Premium Strategic Plan 2019 - 2020

What 2019 Data Tells Us:

- Absence data for 2017-18 for our disadvantaged pupils was 3.4 compared to 5.7 for disadvantaged pupils nationally. No disadvantaged pupils were classed as persistent absentees.
- 20% of disadvantaged pupils are working at a greater depth than the expected standard in reading and writing in our school tracking system.
- 20% of disadvantaged pupils are working towards the expected standard in reading, writing and maths in our school tracking system but are making rapid progress and are diminishing the difference in their attainment between themselves and their peers.

We have decided there are many different ways we can help children at school.

Key Priorities For This Year:



Diminish the difference between disadvantaged and other pupil groups in literacy and numeracy:

- Continue to raise the attainment of disadvantaged pupils in writing at Key Stage 2 to diminish the differences with all pupils nationally
- Ensure that disadvantaged pupils in Key Stage 2 are challenged in order to work at greater depth in reading, writing, maths and science.

Enrichment and enhancement:

- Ensure that disadvantaged pupils are provided with opportunities to develop socially and emotionally as well as academically.
- Support disadvantaged pupils in accessing residential visits and enrichment activities including sports and the arts.
