As you will be aware, all schools are struggling with decreasing budgets. We receive extra money in our budget if children are entitled to free school meals. This money is worth £1320 per pupil. We are urging parents to claim for these meals if you are entitled even if you are receiving universal free school meals because your child is in Key Stage 1 or your child brings a packed lunch. All parents who claim before the beginning of May will be entered into a prize draw with a chance to win a television or a luxury hamper.
