OUR RESPONSE: The highest responses to 'no' were at the end of both Key Stages. It appears, from further analysis, that families in Year2 would like some ideas on how they can further develop their child/ren at home with their maths learning. Year 6 parents/carers who responded to this question feel that home learning at the end of Key Stage 2 should not be optional to support the children with their transition to Secondary school. We will be reviewing our policy over the Summer term and taking these responses into consideration for our 2019 – 2020 Home Learning policy.
