We also encourage you as parents/carers to talk to your child/ren about the importance of reporting any bullying incidents to a member of staff. Through assembly and Personal, Social, Health Education (PSHE) we teach the children about what bullying is and how to report it. If you think at any time that bullying is an issue for your child/ren, please can we encourage you to speak direct to their classteacher.
