Prime Areas

PSED—We have been observing how our beanstalk is growing and using our imagination to think about what would be at the top of our beanstalk.

Physical - We are continuing to practise throwing and catching skills in PE. We have practised the over-head, under arm, bounce and chest pass throws.

Communication and Language—The children have been re-telling the story in order and are beginning to use story language such as 'Once upon a time', 'One day', 'Next' and repetitive phrases such as 'Not by the hair on my chin'.

Specific Areas

Literacy- This week the children have been learning about the Three Little Pigs and writing new endings to the story.

Phonics The children have been re-capping the phase 3 sounds and applying them to their writing.

Maths- The children have been learning about doubles. They have been practising the quick recall of number facts such as $3+3=$ and we used two little pigs and their sticks to help the children to learn this in a fun and engaging way.

Understanding the World- The children have been learning about materials and their qualities. We have linked this to bricks, sticks and straw from the story for building a house.
