On Wednesday the children in Year 5 and 6 visited The National Holocaust Centre as part of their work on World War 2. The visit was very thought provoking as pupils followed the story of Leo, a Jewish boy from Berlin.



Everyone listened to a speech made by Adolf Hitler. He sounded angry and we could see why Leo had been worried about what would happen, especially when the crowd cheered him.



After lunch, we were privileged enough to meet a holocaust survivor - Zdenka Husserl. Zdenka told us how she was rescued from a concentration camp and came to live in England because her mother and father had been killed.



We also visited the memorial garden. This statue was commissioned by another holocaust survivor who hid, with his brother, in a pig sty to escape the soldiers.
