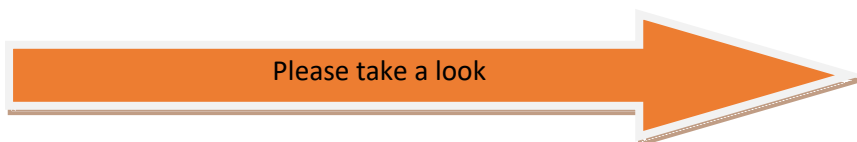
KEY STAGE 2
