The children have been working hard this week on making a little surprise for all of the Mummies for Sunday. Please check your child's book bag for this. We have had another busy week learning all about the traditional tale 'The Three Little Pigs' and some interesting alternative

versions.

## Prime Areas

In PSED, the children have been learning about sharing and taking turns linking this to our story of the week.

**Physical**- During PE the children have been enjoying rolling, catching and throwing balls in the hall.

**Communication and Language** The children have been re-telling the stories in order and are beginning to use story language such as 'Once Upon a Time'.

## Specific Areas

**Literacy**- This week the children have been reading The Three Little Pigs and other alternative versions.

**Phonics**- We have been assessing the children's phonic knowledge and have recapped all of the sounds that have been taught so far and put them into words and sentences.

**Maths**- The children have been learning about halving by sharing into two groups. We have linked this to halving. We have used practical apparatus and then moved onto recording.

**Understanding the World**- The children have been learning about materials and the strongest material to use to build a house. They have been using adjectives to describe how they feel and testing how strong,
