Dear Parents and Carers,

Proposed Change of School Name

As you will be aware, Kestrels' Field Primary School is intending to convert to academy status and join The Mead Educational Trust (TMET) in September 2019.

After careful consideration, the Board of Trustees of The Mead Educational Trust agreed to change the names of its existing schools so that they explicitly reflect their link with The Mead Educational Trust and its family of schools. The current schools in the trust are currently consulting on the proposed names.

On joining The Mead Educational Trust, it is proposed that Kestrels' Field Primary School changes its name to **Kestrel Mead Primary Academy** from 1st September 2019, when it formally joins The Mead Educational Trust.

The change of name will not affect the way in which the school is run. The School will remain committed to ensuring that all children can 'Be the best they can be'.

The consultation runs from **Tuesday 2nd April 2019** closing on **Tuesday 16th April 2019 at noon**.

We would like to take this opportunity to assure parents that students will be able to continue wearing their existing red Kestrels' Field uniforms for as long as they require them. The uniform will remain in red with the school logo after conversion. There is no requirement to purchase an updated uniform unless a replacement is needed e.g. when a pupil outgrows their school jumper. More information will follow shortly about a new supplier for our uniform printing as TESCO has ceased this service.
