

Medium Term Planning Year 5 Summer 2019 – ‘Andy Goldsworthy’.

Session	Learning Intention	Outcome
1	LI: To explore the ideas and techniques used by Andy Goldsworthy.	<p>Show children three shorts clips about Andy Goldsworthy, including a time lapse video of how he created his Stone Domes. http://www.artisancam.org.uk/pages/timelapse.php?artist=andy</p> <p>Share examples of his art work with the children. Discuss the style of the artist. <i>Why do you think Andy Goldsworthy uses natural materials in his artwork?</i> <i>What are the pros/cons of using natural materials?</i> <i>If you could pick one type of material to create a sculpture from what would you pick and why?</i> <i>If you met Andy Goldsworthy and were given the opportunity to ask him one thing about his work what would you ask?</i></p>
2	LI: To question and make thoughtful observations about starting points for their work.	<p>Take the children outside and get them to find one or two items that could be used in a sculpture. Now divide one page of their sketch books into four. Get them to create four different sketches:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none">- A sketch of the whole item- An extremely close-up, detailed sketch of one section of the item (provide magnifying glasses)- The item drawn in an abstract way- Images of the item repeated to create some kind of pattern or design.
3	LI: To use natural materials to create a piece of artwork on an A4 piece of paper.	<p>Look at several examples of how natural materials have been used to create pictures. Put pictures of the artwork on A3 paper, children are to pass these around the room and reflect on what they like about each one and how they were created. Write ideas on post it notes.</p> <p>Get children to plan and design an image of their own that they would like to create. Hand out leaves, stones, sticks etc. for them to do this.</p>

4	LI: To design and plan their own sculpture in the style of Andy Goldsworthy.	<p>Use the trees and tides activity on the artisan cam website to create a picture using natural materials. http://www.artisancam.org.uk/flashapps/treesandtides/treesandtides.php</p> <p>Now plan out what kind of sculpture they want to create. Children are to work in pairs, think about materials needed, colours etc. The plan must be detailed and labelled.</p>
5	LI: To build a sculpture in groups.	<p>Children are to work in groups and using the design they planned out last week create their own sculpture in the style of Andy Goldsworthy. Children must take pictures of their work, as it is made from natural materials outdoors it won't last.</p> <p>Children work in mixed ability groups to create their sculpture.</p>
6	LI: To use technology to manipulate the images of their sculptures.	<p>Children are to manipulate the images of the sculptures they took. Using Camera on the iPads they can crop, resize etc. When finished the children are to print out.</p> <p><i>What ideas have you seen that you would like to try yourself?</i></p> <p><i>What has impressed you?</i></p> <p><i>If you could change one thing about your own piece, what would it be and why?</i></p>
