



## Broadfield Community Primary School Rewards

At Broadfield we are committed to promoting positive behaviours and we use rewards to reinforce to children our expectations in a positive way. All children are encouraged to be the best versions of themselves and we celebrate the children's successes in the following ways:

### **Class Dojo**

Broadfield Community Primary School uses ClassDojo to reward children who follow the school rules. Only 1 point is awarded at any time unless the child achieves Star of the Day status and then they can be awarded 3 dojos. Any member of staff can award children a ClassDojo point. When a pupil reaches 30, 60, 100, 150, 200 and 300 point targets, they will receive a ClassDojo badge and certificate in our celebration assembly. Each academic year, the points are reset to zero. Points may not be taken away.

### **The Best of Broadfield**

Children who consistently display exemplary behaviour and remain on the Green Circle or Gold Star Section of the school sanction system will be rewarded with a Best of Broadfield certificate. This will take place once each half term and parents will be invited to attend the celebration assembly. The children who are the Best of Broadfield will also be invited to participate in the half-termly treat.

### **Achievement Assemblies**

The assemblies will take place once a week for each Unit and children will achieve the following rewards:

ClassDojo certificates and badges for children achieving 30, 60, 100, 150, 200 and 300 Dojo points.

Star of the Week certificates from class teachers.

Attendance trophies for the best attending classes in each Unit.

Star in a Jar prizes for a child from each class for outstanding individual attendance and punctuality.

Birthday celebrations for all children who celebrate their birthday, including sticker and Birthday gift.

*Certificates, trophies and prizes for participation in school activities, e.g. Sports clubs, competitions*

*Annual certificates and prizes.*
