How lucky we are to have such a prestigious event passing through our village. We will be marking the occasion by theming some of our curriculum around 'Le Tour' and of course by finding a safe place on the High Road to stand and wave our flags.

And as many of you will know the event is even more pertinent to the village as ex-pupil and current Yorkshire Road Race Champion, Alex Dalton will be hoping to take part in the race. Our fingers are crossed that he manages to secure a ride with the 'Ribble Pro Cycling' team so that we have reason to wave our flags with even more vigour.

But I suppose in life with every sweet there comes sour. Although the race will bring great interest and enjoyment for the local area, there will also be a degree of disruption. Despite us attending meetings and having discussions with councillors, we have only just this week received the 'anticipated race timings' (which may even change on the day if there are any delays to the start) and we are still not certain about any road closures other than the route itself (they will be announced by the relevant authorities during our Easter Holidays).

As soon as we know more we will send out further details, but for now, hopefully, the following points will help:

1. It is anticipated that the race will arrive in North Ferriby at about 3:10pm.
2. We will be aiming to take the whole school out to watch the race when it comes through the village. The Parish Council has suggested that the safest place for us to watch would be on the grass area near to Medici's restaurant. Children will be brought back to school when it is safe to do so and they will be picked up by parents/carers from their classrooms [NB this is likely to be later than our usual home time]
3. It is likely that there will be road closures between 2:30pm and 4:30pm making it difficult for those travelling to school by car to pick up children at home time.
4. If parents wish to pick up their children early (to avoid travel issues with picking them up at home time) then they will need to do so at **12 noon** - i.e. the end of the morning session.
