Seaside Topic

- Exploring globes and atlas to find out about the continents and the oceans of the world.

Home Learning Project

We would like the children to collect a bag of items from the beach (whatever you find!). This collection will form part of a circle time discussion the first week back and we will use them to create a 'Coastal Collage'
