

Literacy



This term the children will develop their literacy through a range of activities. They will be writing for a range of purposes with a focus on;

- Non-chronological reports
- Poetry
- Recounts

Phonics



Your child will be continuing with the **Letters and Sounds** programme in daily phonics lessons.

Writing

Your child will be applying their knowledge of letter sounds and keywords to write short narratives. We will continue to focus on sentence punctuation, and developing the use of exclamation marks and question marks. The children will be trying to write sentences that use adjectives and conjunctions. Your child will be learning and practising cursive letter formation and simple joins.

Reading

All children will read at least once a week to an adult in school on a one-to-one basis or in a group guided reading session.

All children should continue to read at home and bring their books to school **every day**. Please also remember to use the wonderful online **Bug Club** books.



Art and DT



Your child will have the opportunity to explore, design and create a range of art and DT work throughout the term.

Numeracy

Number work

Your child will be developing their understanding of numbers from 0-100 and beyond. They will be working on solving word problems, and applying their maths skills in a variety of activities.

Calculations

Your child will continue to experience addition and subtraction through a range of practical activities. They will be learning to solve one step problems involving multiplication and division.

Measures

Your child will learn to recognise and know the value of different denominations of coins and notes over the course of the term.

Time

Your child will be learning to tell the time to the hour and half past the hour and draw the hands on a clock face to show these times.

Fractions

Your child will be learning about halves and quarters of numbers and shapes.

Computing



Your child will have the opportunity to further develop their ICT skills by using the internet as a tool to search for information. In addition, they will be accessing a range of educational programs including My Maths to support their learning.
