

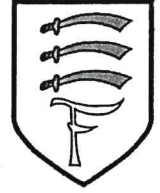

### **Year 5 Sex and Relationships Education**

Next term, we will be covering part of an ongoing programme of Sex and Relationships Education (SRE). These topics cover some elements of Science associated with our topic 'Allotments' which explores lifecycles and development, and some elements of Personal, Social and Health Education (PSHE). More specifically, we will be covering:

- Puberty and hygiene

Your children will be exploring the above topics through examining the following questions:
