Wood Grows

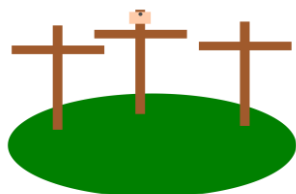
Children had a great time planting trees for our woodland with Manchester City of Trees. Joe is already working on the next phase...a den building and woodland craft area.
