Requests for holidays in term time

We are still receiving a great number of requests from parents wanting to take their children out of school during term time. This is totally unacceptable. The children should be in school for the required 190 school days per academic year, holidays must be taken outside this time. If you decide to take your children out of school during term time, they may be removed from the school roll and as a consequence they will no longer have a place at this school. If any parent does take their child on holiday without permission of the school, we will contact the Educational Social Work Service who may begin proceedings to implement a fixed term penalty. This could result in each parent being fined £60 per child.

Reminder of our Uniform Policy

- *Boys* - Navy blue trousers, **light blue** polo shirt or long/short sleeved light blue shirt, **claret** jumper or sweatshirt bearing the school logo. **Black** coloured footwear, suitable for school, must be worn.
- *Girls* - Navy blue skirts or trousers, light blue polo shirt or long sleeved light blue blouse, **claret** jumper bearing the school logo. During summer months a **blue/white** checked dress or **red/white** checked dress may be worn. **Dark** plain coloured tights and **black** coloured footwear, suitable for school, must be worn.
