Dear Parents/ Guardians,

This week we have been finding out about, and tasting, African fruits. We read Handa's Surprise and discussed the different fruit in the story as well as the sequence. We then used our senses to explore the fruit, describing their texture, look, taste and smell. The children then had the opportunity to create observational drawings using pastels. The job of the week has been to write a sentence to say what they would put in the basket.

In maths we have been finding number partners (bonds) to 6 (3 and 3, 2 and 4 etc), 7 and 8. Children have been recording these in various ways.
