Our Learning this week

In English, we have looked at Christ and the Salvation, with Y6, creating their own script and reenactment of 'The Resurrection'. Y5 have focused on the death of Christ, and created a discussion text about who they believe was at fault for it.

In Maths, Y5 have focused on reading and interpreting tables including timetables. Y6 have focused on Ratio and have looked at how to use ratio appropriately to solve problems.

In Big Idea, Oak Class have explored the following questions: 'What did Jesus do to save human beings?' and 'What difference does the Resurrection make to Christians?'.

In PE, we have focused on our fitness, completing a boxercise circuit. Along with this, we played our first session of rounders, focusing on strategy.

Homework

- Please ensure children are reading at home 4 to 5 times per week. We read on a daily basis at school and this needs to be mirrored at home.
