Our Learning this week

In English this week, children have been learning about Holy Communion. First, we learnt about why it was important through interviewing Reverend Diane, then we planned paragraphs around what a Christian or Catholic child would need to know about their First Holy Communion.

In maths, Year 4 children have been solving problems, involving mixed operations with money. Next half term we will start with converting units of measure. Any exposure to practical measuring activities over the holidays would be very useful.
