## Parking

Below are the road markings found outside of school and the rules that apply to them. Please be mindful when dropping your child off at school and picking them up again on an evening. Thank you.



**No drop off, pick up wait or stop on zigzag lines during the hours of operation.**



**No Parking at any time.**



For a single yellow line a sign will be nearby which advises the hours of operation. When a yellow line is in force all the time the sign will read 'No Waiting at any time' When a single yellow line is in force the same rules apply as for those on a double yellow line.



When a single yellow line is in force the same rules apply as for those on a double yellow line. Remember- You cannot wait or park or you may be liable for a penalty to be served. This also applies if you are present in the vehicle.



Where double kerb markings are present you are not permitted to drop off, pick up, wait or stop. There are no exemptions on this restriction and you can also not load and unload or use a disabled badge to park.

Where there is a single kerb marking there will be an accompanying sign. The sign will be white and read 'no loading'. At the times stated on the sign you must not park there. Outside of these times you need to follow the rules for the yellow lines as outlined above.
