

You will be given 3 weekly activities that must be done. In addition, you have a further 4 activities you could choose from below. We are hoping you will put in a lot of effort for each piece and you will enjoy sharing all your hard work with the rest of the class.

WEEKLY	Reading (At least three times a week). Spellings (Practise your spellings for your test). Complete the weekly home learning task set by Miss Moseley.	
TERMLY	<u>Wonderful wind!</u> Can you feel the wind blowing? Hold a piece of ribbon or a scarf in your hand and stand outside. Can you see it moving in the wind? Is it moving a little bit or a lot? Look around you. Describe which forces you can see. Is the wind blowing the trees or anything else? Draw a picture to show the effect the wind has on the ribbon or scarf.	<u>Snow flour</u> Pour a little pile of flour onto the table. Imagine that the flour is snow. What would you like to do in the snow? Spread the snow out on the table with your hands. Can you make patterns in the snow? Can you write your name? Take a photo of this activity and stick it in your home learning book.
	<u>Puddle fun!</u> The next time it rains, go out puddle jumping with a grown-up. Put on your wellies and jump in the puddles. What words would you use to describe the puddles? What sounds can you hear when you jump in them? It is up to you how you record this; it could be a poem, an annotated photo/drawing, the choice is yours!	<u>Mathletics</u> This is a fun online maths resource that the school has made available to you. Play games, solve puzzles and challenge yourself and your friends. Your login details will be inside your home learning books. Please include your score, the date and maths subject in your home learning book.
