



Year 2 Summer Term

- **Language, Oracy and Literacy**
This term the children will be reading stories from different traditions and cultures. They will be writing a letter to Greenpeace about conservation and writing a diary entry from a boy from Brazil.

- **Mathematics**
This term in mathematics we will continue to learn about shape. We will also be learning about collecting and presenting data.

- **Science and Technology**
The children will be identifying different types of plants and the parts of a plant. We will be learning about animals, including humans and what they need to survive and stay healthy.

- **Citizenship and Ethics**
Children are thinking about relationships between their families, friends and other adults.

Theme title
Jungle Fever

Context: This term the children will be learning about how to grow vegetables and plants, where food comes from and why some animals/mini beasts are very important for our environment.

- **Arts and Creativity**
We will look at the artists; De Vinci and Andy Goldsworthy and how to create art from natural resources.
- **Place and Time**
We will be looking at different environments that promote healthy growth for plants and the animals that live there.

- **Faith and Belief**
The children will be revisiting the Easter story and what it means to Christians.

Physical and Emotional Health
This term the children will be looking at basic movements including, running, jumping, throwing and catching. We will be learning about the importance of exercise, eating the right amounts of different types of food and how hygiene is important.
