



## Summer 2019 Planning Overview

### Upper 1

Subject	Coverage
Science	<p><i>Animals</i></p> <p>Pupils will look to construct and interpret a variety of food chains, identifying producers, predators and prey. They will explore the differences in the life cycles of a mammal, an amphibian, an insect and a bird.</p>
Computing	<p><i>Publishing on the Internet</i></p> <p>To look at the Internet and to discuss the different things we can do on the Internet and how it has made our lives easier as well as more dangerous (Internet Safety). Pupils will attempt to make their own online book and to illustrate it as well.</p>
Art	<p><i>Animals and Birds</i></p> <p>To use drawing, painting and sculpture to develop and share their ideas, experiences and imagination. Pupils will also learn about the work of a range of artists, describing the differences and similarities and making links to their own work.</p>
PSHCE	<p><i>Relationships/Changing Me</i></p> <p>This Jigsaw unit focuses on talking about the relationships we have with family and friends - from how to make friends to solving friendship problems when they occur. This unit is all about building socially resilient children so they can better deal with adversity if and when it arises.</p> <p>The changing me aspect will see us covering a range of activities and lessons around going through puberty and entering into adolescence.</p>
Music	<p><i>Keyboard and Percussion</i></p> <p>To explore rhythm and pulse within music.</p>



	<p>Pupils will also have the opportunity to do some 'call and response' rhythm activities as well as some body percussion exercises. They will also have a go at composing their own piece of music!</p>
Drama	<p><i>Journeys Through Time/Rock Challenge</i>          Students will be involved in activities based around this theme that will include using different voices, singing, movement and dance. They will take part in team work activities such as parachute games. The students will use drama techniques from improvisation to role play to prepare for the Rock Challenge finals in June.</p>
PE	<p><i>Team Games</i>          This term's PE focus will be on a variety of team games in preparation for competitions off site and with other schools. There will also be a focus on individual sports in preparation for sports day and Disport. This will cover skills such as throwing, catching, running, jumping, passing/handing etc. We will also do some activities for Healthy Eating Week in June.</p>
Geography	<p><i>Our World</i>          In this unit we will look at Asia and the customs and traditions present in that culture. We will look particularly at Korea and their celebrations throughout the year. We may even have an opportunity to prepare and try some food.</p>
DT	<p><i>Soups, Pizza and Snacks</i>          This term's DT lessons will focus on the making of simple soups and snacks. Skills that will be practised include washing, cutting, dicing, spreading, grating etc.</p>
History	<p><i>Roman Brough</i>          In this unit we will look at the ancient Romans and how they influenced the current UK we live in today. We will specifically look at there</p>



	settlement in Brough and the petuaria or fort that was built there. We may also make a trip to the Museum in Hull to further research the Romans in Brough.
RE	<i>Our World</i> This unit will help the pupils to learn about some of the different religious practises of our world. We will look at the similarities and differences between these religions and where in the world they are practised.

**This term will see us going off site as a class to partake in a Paintbox Experience with Hull Children's University. We will also be going on an end of year trip to a venue that will be chosen by the pupils (i.e. cinema, café, restaurant etc.)**
