

Subject	Unit description
Functional Skills Maths, English, Computing	Students will be working towards the AQA unit award scheme. This includes English, Maths and Computing. They will be working on a variety of tasks to prepare them for future assessments.
AQA Skills for Independent Living Skills for Social Well Being Skills for the Workplace Skills for Leisure	Students will be working towards qualifications covered by the AQA unit award scheme. The qualification will be divided into units covering Communication, Numeracy, Computing, Home Management, Personal Skills and Workplace. These units are: Social communication Collecting and presenting data Using ICT in the community Working with others in the workplace Shopping in the community Preparing picnic and buffet food Using a café Using a zebra/pelican crossing
Work Experience	Some students will have local external placements and others in-house placements. They will follow a qualification in Work-right or AQA units relating to their place of work.
Science	Students will cover electrical safety, changing materials, being healthy, recycling, health and safety, temperatures and plants/growing throughout the different aspects of the curriculum
Humanities	Students will learn about current affairs and other special days which take place during the Summer Term: This includes things such as Father's day, Bullying, mental health awareness week and science week.
Drama	Students will take part in lessons which will be led by St. Anne's Drama teacher. This term they will be working on individual targets through a variety of ways. We will also be completing a 10 week course on Drama skills with a member of staff from Hull Truck Theatre- this will include games, performance, dance, drama, singing and a visit behind the scenes at the theatre.
Community Practical Maths & English	Students will visit a variety of supermarkets, shopping centres, town centres. The students will locate items, identify different types of shops and ask workers in the shops for assistance when necessary. There will be opportunities to use cafes in the community to experience using money to purchase drinks and snacks.
PSHE	Students will work on the Jigsaw programme following the relationship and changing me topics. Students will learn to identify their own relationships with others through working within groups, partnerships and 1:1 sessions. They will also learn about healthy living to link with AQA units.
PE	The students will develop skills to then take part in team games ready for upcoming sports events. These will include: throwing, catching, batting and following instructions etc. They will take part in sports day and offsite sports activities. They will also take part in 'Healthy Eating Week' activities 10 th - 14 th June.
Expressive Arts	This term students will be completing work on about graffiti. This will include making a piece of graffiti inspired work and visiting a local display of graffiti work.
RE	This term students will study the topic 'caring for our world'. They will do this by exploring creation stories, beginning to discover some of the religious ideas and start to consider the ways in which the world is a special place and how it should be cared for.
