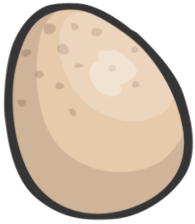
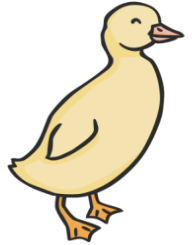
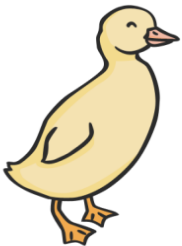


## The Ugly Duckling

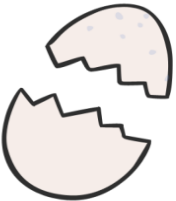
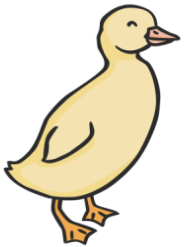
This term in Year 1 our topic will be focused on the story 'The Ugly Duckling'. We are going to be reading this story and looking at familiar settings, characters and events, building up to some inspirational writing. Other skills in English will include continuing to form correctly the lower case letters and capital letters. We will also work on the Year 1 spelling and phonics rules. In Reading, we will continue to look at the main events in the story and look at the reasons for the events in the story.



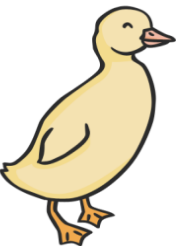
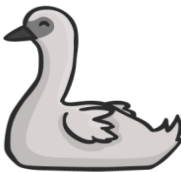
In Maths, we are continuing our number work up to and over 20, plus learning to count in 5's to 60 forwards and back. We will also work on number bonds to 20. We will be adding and subtracting one and two digit numbers up to 20. We are also going to be learning about numbers to 50, ordering and comparing them and learning how to represent them in different ways. We will be measuring length, height, weight, volume and capacity.



Our topic will include Science work on animals and continuing work on plants and trees during the Spring/ Summer season, Geography work on the local area, Art work on printing and textiles, Music work on rhythm and pitch, Computer work on Online safety, coding and digital content, R.E looking at faith in the community and special groups we belong to, PSHEC we will look at valuing differences and using the traditional tale of the Ugly Duckling as a starting point. In P.E we will focus on athletics and games.
