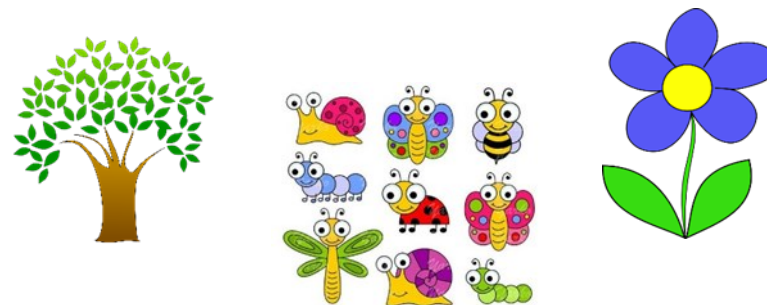
The first set of spellings will be sent home on Friday 26th April.

Maths

In maths this half term we will be learning about;

- place value
- addition and subtraction
- position, direction and movement
- Bar graphs and pictograms

How can you help at home?

- ⇒ practise counting forwards and backwards, count in steps of 2, 5 and 10
- ⇒ practise pairs of numbers to make 5, 10 and 20 (and 100 –year 2)
- ⇒ continue to learn 2x, 5x and 10x tables— year 2

Science

The objectives we will cover this half term are to:

- identify and name a variety of plants and trees
- identify and describe the basic structure of plants
