

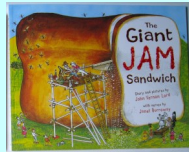
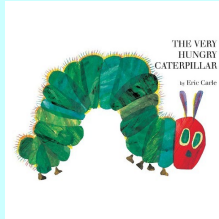
## Literacy

Taking care of our environment and making it suitable for all the insects and mini-beasts that live in our outdoor area.

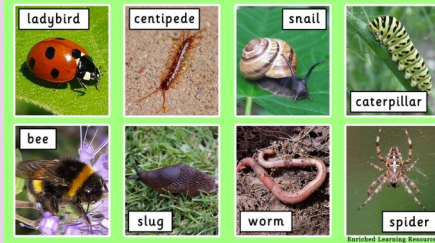
## MATHS
