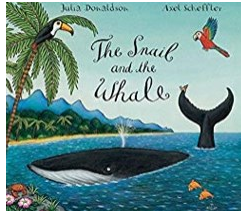
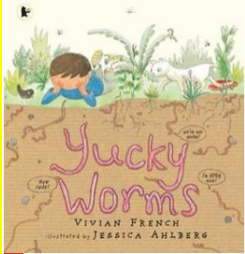


ENGLISH

Music

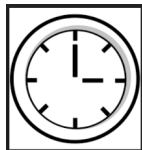
In Music the children will be learning the Friendship Song. The children will be carrying out a performance for parents before half term.

MATHS

During May the children will be sitting their SATS. In our normal Maths lessons we will be learning about fractions. The children will be able to find $1/4$, $1/3$, $1/2$, $2/4$, $3/4$ of a number or shape.



We will also be looking at time. The children will be learning to tell the time to the nearest 15 minutes. They will be using language like quarter past and quarter to. To support this learning try to encourage the children to tell the time at home.



ART & DESIGN TECHNOLOGY

In art the children will be looking at animals from the 7 continents of the world and will represent these in unique and exciting ways. They will create aboriginal art, 3D models and totem poles.



In DT the children will design purposeful, functional, appealing products for themselves and other users based on design criteria. They will be making an animal puppet to share with their peers.

Visits and Visitors

The children will be visiting Barton Springs, a local nature reserve. We will be focusing on local habitats, trees and plants.

We will be visited by some furry friends!

SCIENCE—Growth and Survival

The children will identify and name a variety of plants and animals in their habitats.

They will learn that animals, including humans, have offspring which grow into adults

They will also find out about and describe the basic needs of animals, including humans, for survival (water, food and air)

PE

In indoor PE, the children will be participating in a multi skill festival.

In out door PE the children will be completing outdoor adventure activities, including trails. They will be working on team work activities as well.

GEOGRAPHY

In Geography the children will name and locate the world's 7 continents and 5 oceans.



They will look at animals that are native to that continent. They will learn how and why the animals are important to the country they live in.



Computing

The children will be introduced to making music digitally using Purple Mash. They will explore, edit and combine sounds using 2Sequence. They will add sounds to a tune they've already created to change it.

The children will upload a sound from a bank of sounds into the Sounds section.

They will also create their own sounds to add to their piece of music.



RE In RE the children will be answering the question: How do we show we care for others?

PSHE In PSHE the children will be studying a unit called medicines and me. They will learn about what happens when you go to the doctors and how to keep themselves safe around medicines. They will also learn about asthma.
