Dear Parent/Carers

**Tour de Yorkshire – Thursday 2 May 2019**

As you will be aware, we are fortunate enough to be having the ‘Yorkshire le Tour’ racing through our village on Thursday 2 May 2019. Although we will not be entirely sure of the correct timings until the day itself, this is likely to be happening towards or at the end of the school day.

As yet no information has been released regarding any road closures other than the rolling closure of the race route, however due to the potentially high interest in the race and the route closure itself, traffic is likely to be slow causing potential issues for pick up at the end of the day.

For this reason, if you feel that you might have a problem arriving on time for pick up at the end of the day, or if you wish to come and enjoy the event with your child, then we are suggesting that you pick up your child at **12 noon** on that day, this will ensure you avoid and are clear of the anticipated traffic issues. **Please ensure your child tells their class teacher that day if they are going home for lunch. Please also be aware that all children going home will receive a “special circumstances” absence mark in the register for the afternoon session (not an “unauthorised” absence).**

At the time of the race we will then walk the remaining children from school to the top of church road to watch the race as it goes through.

Once the race has gone through the village we will return the children to the classrooms to be collected by parents and carers.

Please note that due to the potential congestion in the village, we will not release your child from their classroom unless someone we know has arrived to collect them. In the case of older children, if you still wish them to walk home by themselves then we must have written permission from you allowing them to do so on this particular day. No children can be collected whilst we are off site.

The Women’s race the following day will be taking a different route therefore will not cause any disruption.
