Foundation Subjects

Science: In Science this half term we will be learning about animals. We will be;

- Identifying and naming common animals including amphibians, reptiles, birds and mammals.
- Identifying and naming animals that are carnivores, herbivores and omnivores.
- Describing and comparing the structure of a variety of common animals.

Geography: We will create maps of the continents and of Australia. We will be comparing and contrasting the UK and Australia, looking at climate, physical features and landscapes. Along with this we will also be looking at cultures and lifestyles.

Computing: Our Computing unit this term is called 'We are Collectors' and we using Microsoft PowerPoint and the Internet to find, cut and paste images of different types of animals into sorted pages. This links well with our Science work.

RE: In RE this half term we will be looking at special things in nature. We will be learning about the importance and beauty of the natural world and how we need to look after it.

PE: This half term we will be working on agility improving our ball skills.

Art: Alongside our mapping work in geography, we will explore Dreamtime artwork to produce some painted dot pictures of our own.

Music: In Music we will be learning a song called 'Your imagination' and using to develop our improvisation skills.

PSHCE: This half term is called 'Getting on and falling out' and we will be exploring the qualities we look for and need to develop in order to have and be a good friend.
