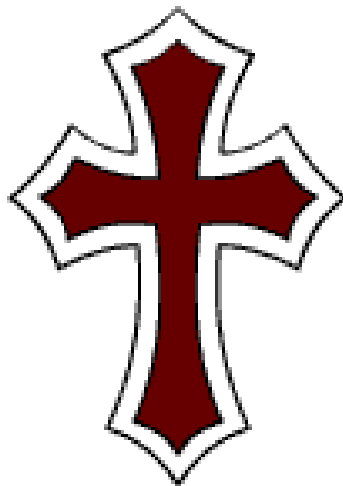


# St Thomas More Catholic Primary

Monday morning assemblies are usually led by the Headteacher, but may be led by any member of staff. The children are also encouraged to lead and take part in any gathering together session. Our children prepare the bidding prayers for assembly.

The assemblies highlight the Liturgical Year celebrations but may also be used to discuss and reflect on other issues relevant to the children from world events or news. Visiting speakers may attend therefore there may be changes to the calendar.

### Merit awards

Certificates will be awarded for excellent work, contribution to school life, attitude etc

The class teacher will nominate 2 children from each class. If relevant, the child will bring their work into assembly and will be asked to explain why their class teacher has nominated them and show their work to the rest of the children.

The children will each be given a Headteacher's Award sticker and a certificate. Names and reasons of merit award winners are on our weekly school newsletter

### Lunchtime awards

2 children are awarded each week for eg excellent behaviour, contribution to school life

### In school awards

Eg for Lexia. Certificates are presented. A group photo goes on the school newsletter.

### Out of school awards

Children to bring in relevant out of school awards for eg sporting events and these are presented in assembly. A group photo goes on the school newsletter.
