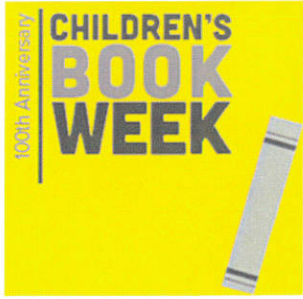

# READ NOW, READ

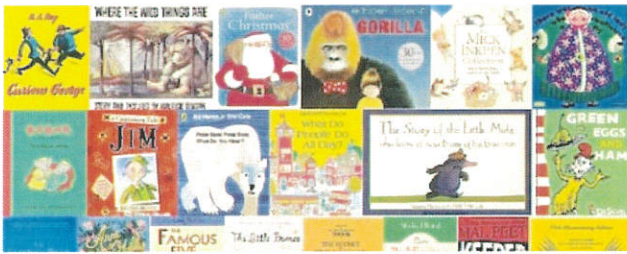
