Year 1 will be visiting the Roald Dahl Children's Gallery on **Friday 28th June** for **Elephant and Rhino class** and on **Monday 1st July** for **Giraffe and Hippo class**.

During the day we will be taking part in investigating history, natural history, science and technology through practical hands on activities relating to museum objects.

The following workshop activities that will be included are:

An introduction to Dahl's stories, his life, how he wrote his stories and where he got his fantastic ideas from. Act out the scene from Charlie and the Chocolate Factory where poor Augustus Gloop gets stuck in the bubble tube as well as becoming one of the angry farmers and follow Fantastic Mr Fox on his adventures! The children will need to be brought to school at the usual time on the day of their visit; they will travel to the Roald Dahl Children's Gallery by coach accompanied by school staff and will return to school for the usual 3pm collection time. The kitchen will provide a packed lunch for this day (choices to be sent via parentmail shortly).

Children will need to wear their school uniform and should have the following:
