'Sailing the Seas'

English

We will be 'Writing to Entertain' this term. This means we will be learning how to plan and write stories for the purpose of entertaining the reader. We will start by reading 'Ocean Meets Sky' – the children will write descriptions of settings, make inferences about characters and then write their own version of the story.

Maths

We will be learning how to tell the time to quarter hours, how to measure capacity in ml/l, how to measure temperature and how to find weight in g/kg.
