



Upper 2 – Summer 2019

SCIENCE – Animals

Students will identify and name a variety of common creatures that are birds, fish, animals and insects. They will learn about where they live and what they eat. They will look at lifecycles and how animals, including humans, have offspring which grow into adults.

PSHCE – Relationships and Changes

Students will think about people who are special to them, begin to appreciate them and how they feel about their relationship with this person. Students will learn the main body parts that make boys and girls different and recognise the correct names for them. They will begin to understand that some parts of their body are private.

ART- Animals and Birds

Students will look at artists work of animals and birds from the past and other cultures. They will experience, explore use a range of materials and media e.g. paint, chalk, collage. They will use the computer to colour in pictures online and draw their own pictures using drawing applications.

DT – Soups, Pizzas and Snacks

Students will explore ingredients through looking, tasting, touching and smelling and share with the group their opinion of them. They will learn about healthy eating, practical preparation skills, safety and hygiene in the kitchen. They will prepare a variety of soups, pizzas and snacks to take home to share.

GEOGRAPHY – Our World

Students will have the opportunity to use world maps, atlases and globes to explore beyond the UK and Europe to all the seven continents and five oceans. Students will use the internet to find out more about other areas of the world and watch videos showing how other people live similar or different lives to them.

HISTORY – Roman Brough

Students will learn that Romans lived in Brough a long time ago and that their lives were very different to ours. They will look at how the Romans lived and will have the opportunity to handle actual artefacts from the time. They will explore Roman art and foods.

COMPUTING – We are Painters

Students will create illustrations for an eBook. They will use the internet safely to find ideas for illustrations. They will select and use painting tools to create and change images on the computer. With appropriate support, they will be encouraged to save, retrieve and change their work.

RE – Our World

Students will explore creation stories from different religions including Christianity as well as traditional faiths such as Aboriginal Dreamtime. They will consider the ways in which the world is a special place and how it should be cared for and be involved in practical ways of looking after our world eg growing plants and litter picking.

MUSIC – Keyboards and Percussion

The students will listen to a range of classical and popular music which have a large keyboard or percussion element. They will be given opportunities to learn and perform new and familiar songs. Students will have the opportunity to play keyboard and percussion instruments and to perform to the class.

PE – Sports

The students will develop skills to then take part in team games ready for upcoming sports events. These will include throwing, catching, batting, running and following instructions etc. They will also take part in Disport, the National School Sports week in June and our whole school Festival of Sport.
