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Dear Parents,

Welcome back to the last term of this school year! We hope you had a lovely holiday with your children; it is lovely to see them back and hear about what they have been doing. You will soon receive a Summer Term Newsletter with details about this term's curriculum content.

In Literacy, the children have been writing about their Easter holidays. Next week we will be doing activities based on the story 'Super Daisy' including using describing words to make our writing more interesting e.g 'Daisy has a cape' could be written in a more interesting way, such as 'Daisy has a flowing, red cape'. Perhaps the children can spot describing words in stories you read together at home?

In Maths this week, the children have been doing some activities based on estimation. We will be revisiting 3D shape next week. We will be focusing on the properties of 3D shapes - cube/cuboid/cylinder/cone/sphere. It would be great if you could encourage your child to identify shapes at home or when you are out and about. What can they tell you about shapes they see? Any real life 3D shapes or pictures/photographs of 3D shapes they have found are welcome for our Mathematician board.

Just a reminder....please make sure that your child's clothing is clearly labelled - particularly cardigans and jumpers. We often have a collection when the warmer weather comes along! We hope that the weather will improve and become warmer again as we head towards summer! When it is a warm sunny day, please remember that children in Foundation spend a large amount of the day outside and so it is really important that they bring a named cap/hat with them and that you apply sun cream in the morning before they come to school.
