I am delighted to let you know that our school has been successful with a bid through the Tesco Bags of Help Grant Scheme and our bid will be in the Tesco's in Driffield from Wednesday 1st May to Sunday 30th June.

Some of the wording for our bid :

“Kilham Primary School is introducing a new reading project which will see a new focus on a collaborative approach to reading between the school, the parents and the children. As part of the project children in class will all have a single copy of an exciting modern book which they will discuss with their class and with their teacher.

Our school will also use the funding to update our ageing reading stock with class sets of new titles, new authors and books that will especially encourage boys to read. As we are especially trying to encourage older boy readers, we will be updating our reading stock with graphic novels and books that inspire boys. The project will also look at a greater level of involvement with parents. The event will be launched with an exciting 30-day reading challenge event, and children will also be involved in voting for their top 10 class books.”

As you can see our focus is on our reading stock and engagement with reading – a very worthy cause. Our project will run alongside two other projects with blue tokens being used by shoppers to vote for the project of your choice. The project with the highest number of votes at the store will win £4,000, 2nd place will win £2,000, and 3rd place gets £1,000. As you can imagine £4,000 would be an amazing amount to contribute to new reading stock.
