Swimming

Our children learn to swim in year 5.

At the beginning of Year 5 swimming lessons 25 children could confidently swim 25 meters the rest were classified by their parents and staff as unconfident. There were 30 in the year group. By the end of the swimming sessions 28 children could swim 25 meters and only 2 children remained as unconfident swimmers.

The children learn the following strokes: front crawl, back stroke and butterfly.

All children were aware of the dangers of water and how to keep themselves safe. In addition, more advanced swimmers were taught basic life skills.

The confident children reported a growth in swimming ability as they learned a new stroke – Butterfly, with which they were not previously familiar!
