Residential Trip to Osmington Bay in 2020

Dear Parents/Carers,

After successful residential visits to Osmington Bay with our Year 5 children, we are delighted to invite your child to a residential trip at the same venue in 2020.

Osmington Bay is a multi-activity centre run by PGL. During the week the children will take part in an exciting range of activities such as –

- Climbing
- Abseiling
- Archery
- Fencing
- Jacobs Ladder
- Trapeze
- Raft Building
- Giant Swing
- Zip Wire
- Sensory Trail
- Mountain Biking
- Street Surfing

In addition to the day activities, evening entertainment is provided as well. The activities and residential are designed to encourage teamwork, confidence and sharing as well as an increased sense of responsibility, which it is hoped, will all be taken on both at home and at school.

The residential trip will take place from **Monday 27th April to Friday 1st May 2020.**

The cost of the residential trip is **£327** which includes coach travel to and from Weymouth, 18 different activity sessions, instruction from highly trained and externally qualified Activity Group Leaders, full board accommodation and travel insurance cover.

Please complete the slip below and return it to the school office with a deposit of **£47 by Friday 17th May 2019** if you would like your child to take part in this fantastic experience.

I appreciate that this is a long time before the trip itself, however as we are booking now, this price includes an Early Booking Discount from PGL. Your child will then be issued with a trip payment card. The money can be paid in one lump sum or in instalments between now and next January. More information on dates and amounts for these instalments will follow.

We understand that this is a large financial commitment and if there are any difficulties in reaching the full amount, please let us know and we will contact you to see if we can find a solution. We will not involve the children, as we feel it is best not to worry them about this.

An information session about the trip will take place nearer the event.
