Biographies and autobiographies, instructions and explanations, poetry including narrative poetry, journalistic writing, fantasy writing and myths. Inference and deduction from the text, understanding vocabulary, summaries and composing questions about a text. Performance poetry for competition. Paragraphs to organise ideas, commas in clauses, direct speech and speech marks, modal verbs, brackets and dashes, range of sentence types to engage the reader in different genres of writing, past perfect and progressive verbs, exclamation marks and suffixes, colons and semi colons, coordinating and subordinating conjunctions.

Spelling - ancy, ency and ation, homophones and near homophones, silent letters, confusing nouns and verbs, prefixes and suffixes, all Y4 / Y5 word list to read and spell.

Use dictionaries to check the spelling and meaning of words.

Proof-read and edit writing.

Legible, correctly formed, joined handwriting.

Maths

Geometry - angles (measuring and drawing), shape (3D and 2D characteristics), position and direction. Measurements - converting units related to length and volume.

Measuring volume. Perimeter and area. Prime numbers. Statistics.

Weekly arithmetic and tables activities and test.
