What we will be learning:

Maths

In Maths, the children will be consolidating their knowledge on place value. They will also learn about statistics. They will look at a variety of different tally charts, pictograms and bar charts. The children will then move onto learning about position direction and movement and understand the mathematical terminology. Around this topic.

English

In English, the children will be reading stories based on the rainforest. They will be creating information posters based on a rainforest animal. This will include researching and presenting the information they have found. Also, they will be writing kenning poems about the sounds and sights of the rainforest.

Science

In Science, the children will be learning about plants. They will be naming a variety of different plants and learning about what they need to survive. The children will be carrying out lots of different experiments based on plants and describing the basic structure of them.



Art

In Art, the children will have lots of opportunities to create large scale paintings and drawings of the plants and animals of the rainforest. They will be learning about Henri Rousseau and studying his paintings. They will be using layering techniques to create their own Henri Rousseau style picture.

RE - Family ties

In this unit pupils will explore the idea of celebration and what a celebration involves before going on to find out about customs and rituals associated with the Hindu celebration of Raksha Bandhan. They will also learn about the importance of family in religious celebrations and begin to ask questions about the importance of different people in their family and how to show their appreciation of this importance.

Thematic - Rumble in the Jungle

In our Thematic curriculum, the children will be using maps to locate Brazil and identifying the similarities and differences between Brazil and England. They will be learning about a variety of different animals that live in the rainforest and all about their habitat. Towards the end of the theme, the children will be learning about deforestation and the effect it has on the animals and people that live in the rainforest.

Trip: We are looking at a visit to Bird Land, Leicestershire to go with this theme. This will incur a charge for your child but I am sure you will agree it will benefit their learning.
