Can you label the key parts of a plant?</p>	<p><u>Art</u></p> <p>Draw a rainforest animal using a media of your choice. Please include bright colours.</p>
<p><u>ICT</u></p> <p>Create a poster about one aspect of the rainforest. Use pictures and text.</p>	<p><u>D + T</u></p> <p>Make a shoebox rainforest. Please include lots of plants and animals. Can you label the different layers of the rainforest?</p>	<p><u>Music</u></p> <p>Make a musical instrument using recycled materials for the Rio Carnival.</p>	<p><u>Geography</u></p> <p>Using a map of the world, find the different rainforests and colour them in on your map. Can you label the countries the rainforests are in?</p>
<p><u>RE</u></p> <p>Find out which famous religious statue overlooks Rio and draw it. How tall is it? What is it made from?</p>	<p><u>Science</u></p> <p>Other than rainforest, what other habitats do you know? Draw and label them. What kinds of animals would live in these habitats?</p>	<p><u>PE</u></p> <p>Create a rainforest themed animal warm up which includes stretches. These will be used in our PE sessions.</p>	<p><u>English</u></p> <p>Write 10 interesting facts about the rainforest.</p>
