Thank you for all your kind comments about our new badge. Please talk to your children about it, they are more than able and happy to talk to you about its' meaning.



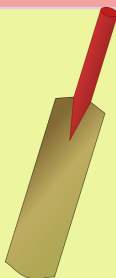
## Smart Team Kits

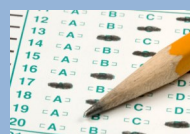
## Barrow Water day
