Our Contact team is expanding and there are opportunities for flexible working. We would like to include in our teams people who could work twilight shifts, from 3 - 6pm and weekends.

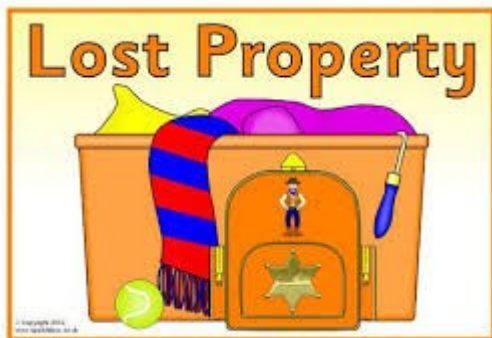
Training will be provided to support you in these roles.
