This week we have been reading Jasper's Beanstalk by Nick Butterworth and Mick Inkpen which led to learning about the key parts of a plant (petal, stem, root, leaf) and what plants need to grow. The role play area has become a garden centre and some children have enjoyed planting their own sunflower seeds. The maths this week has also tied in with the story of Jasper's Beanstalk. We have thought about language which relates to time (first, next, after that, then etc) and ordered the days of the week before learning more about telling the time using o'clock. This week we have also been adding single digits by counting on from the larger number.

We are really pleased with the progress children are making with phonics. Thank you for your continued support at home in practising to read with your child. Please remember to use the word cards alongside reading books to reinforce the phonics that has been taught.

Things to note:

- The children have enjoyed their Goal Sports PE lesson on a Wednesday afternoon and have been learning to throw and catch alongside other ball skills. Please ensure your child has a pair of trainers at school for outdoor PE.
- A reminder that as the weather improves a sun hat and named sun cream at school is recommended.
