Literacy (Reading and Writing)

As readers we will continue to develop our phonics skills by working on Phase 4 and learning how to read words with adjacent consonants.

By looking at whole class texts and small group guided reading we will work on answering comprehension questions and making predictions.

To develop our understanding of different jobs we will read a selection of stories linked to our theme.

Following our real-life visits from 'Everyday Superheroes', we will write facts about different occupations, write questions to ask the visitors and make posters to help the 'Everyday Superheroes'.

Physical Development

To support our physical development we will continue to use our outdoor area to promote fitness using our trim trail and other equipment.

In our PE lessons we will be focussing on developing our basic skills of balance, balls skills, dance and gymnastics.

To support our understanding of Health and Self-Care we will enjoy a visit from a nurse who will teach us ways to keep fit and healthy.

Our school cleaners will be talking to us about how they help to keep our school clean and safe and how we can help them to do this.

Maths

As mathematicians we are going to be working on the numbers 11-20. We will look at how ten ones make ten and then will continue adding 1 to make all of the numbers to 20. We will use the 'Number Blocks' to help us gain a deeper understanding.

In our provision both indoors and outdoors we will use construction materials to build models and have a focus on 3d shapes. We will learn their names and how to describe them. To deepen our understanding and reasoning we will investigate which shapes are the best to build with.

Social, Spiritual, Moral and Cultural

As members of a Church of England school we will be exploring our school values of **courage, forgiveness, thankfulness** and **our community** in collective and class worship. We will continue to access our classroom worship area and enjoy stories linked to our school values and deliver worships to parents.

Understanding the World

As scientists we are going to investigate which gloves are best for 'Fireman Sam' to use when he is working. We will learn the important parts of lots of different occupations and think about how those people help the world around us.

Using the iPads, we will begin to learn how to code by using the 'Beebot' app. Giving the bee instructions, we will guide it out of the mazes.

We will continue to look after the plants in our outdoor area.

Expressive Art and Design

As designers we will work on using our 'Self Service Paint Station' to mix colours and create our own works of art.

We will work in teams to create junk box model vehicles for our 'Everyday Superheroes'. It will be important for them to have moving parts so we will learn about different joining techniques. We will evaluate our models and improve them.

Personal, Social and Emotional Development (PSED)

To support our PSED we will be continuing with our team circle times to support behaviour and social development. We will work on developing our confidence of making new friends and interactions with others. During our circle times we will be practising our turn taking and sharing with other children. We will think about what we would like to do when we grow up.

Communication and Language

To develop our speaking skills, we will learn how to ask questions and answer them. We will talk about different jobs and people who help us, thinking about what we might like to be when we grow up.

We will develop our listening skills by listening to information given to us by the various visitors we have coming to talk to us this half term.
