


## Year 4 Learning Leaflet Summer 2019

### *Our topic is: Boudicca's Battle*

Subject	We will be learning to:	Homework ideas Places to visit Useful websites
	<p>Identify the different purposes of persuasive texts and analyse the language and structural features of persuasive texts. Gather information from various sources and present this in the form of an information text.</p> <p>Understand film narrative and understand character motives. To write a story based on the film narrative.</p>	<p>Practise spellings.</p> <p>Read regularly with your child and ask them questions about the text.</p> <p>Look up information about our topic together.</p>
	<p>Recall multiplication and division facts up to 12x12. Read Roman numerals to 100 (I to C). Add and subtract 4-digit numbers using the formal written method. Estimate and use the inverse operation to check answers. Solve two-step problems in contexts. Recognise and use factor pairs. Multiply two-digit and three-digit numbers by a one-digit number. Divide using a formal written method of short division. Estimate, compare and calculate different measures. 	<p>Children will investigate living things and their habitats by identifying and naming a variety of living things within the local environment. 	<p>To understand networks and create their own programs to use in class. We will use digital media to explore Celtic stories. Supervise them when using technology to ensure they are using it appropriately and safely.</p>
	<p>To examine Boudicca's chariot and draw their own design. From their designs children will construct a chariot with moving parts.</p>	<p>Discuss how things are made with your child.</p>

Support your child to develop their throwing and catching skills. Take them to the park, play basketball, football and other games together.
Personal, Social and Health Education	Share ideas to help with keeping safe, managing feelings and coping with change.	Ask your child about their day at school.
History 	To place historical events and figures on a timeline using dates.
